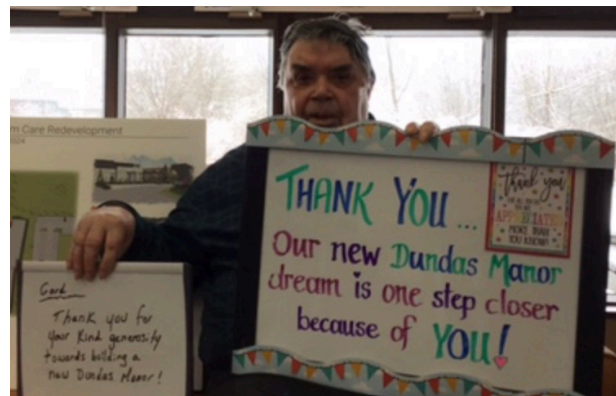
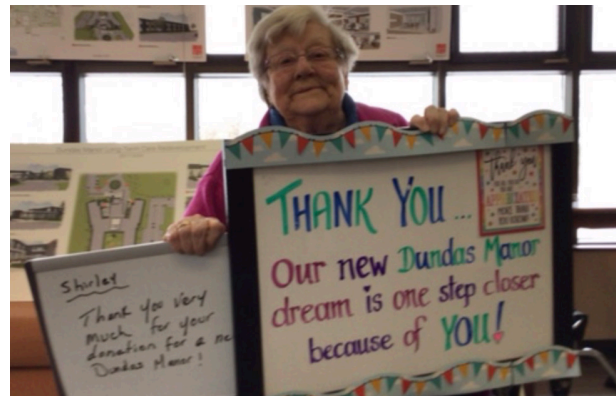
They say that a picture is worth a thousand words. So we want to start off our second *Your Dundas Manor Dream* newsletter with some great ones.

### It's Official

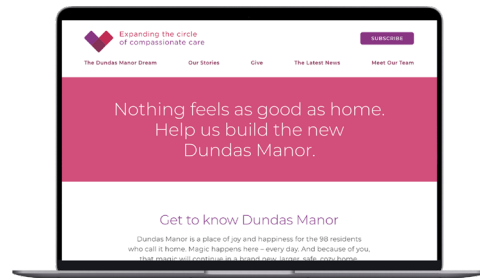

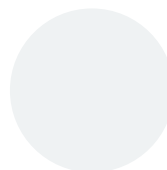
